**I recently met with the Chancellor of the Exchequer to discuss the future of the Eastern Bypass**

Working with Lincolnshire County Council and the Department for Transport, I have secured over £100m of funding for the long awaited Eastern Bypass.

The Eastern Bypass is vital for Lincoln's long term economic future. This is why I will fight to ensure that the project goes ahead. New businesses will only invest in Lincoln if they see a transport network suitable for a 21st Century City.

I recently met with the Chancellor of the Exchequer, The Rt. Hon. George Osborne MP, who confirmed that despite the delays caused by planning requirements, the £50m government funding has been ring fenced. The Department for Transport have also confirmed their support for any future scheme to include a dualling of the Eastern Bypass.
